All the dates are a Sunday unless otherwise stated.

Club Comps: For these shoots all members can enter but only those who have entered can shoot that day. An entry form will be out closer to the day to explain what the shoots is about(includes the spoon shoots: June, July, August).

League : The League shoots will be either home or away. They will be shot over a 9 dozen round called a Windsor (60y, 50y, 40y). The teams (of up to 8) will be decided 2 weeks before the day. Sighters are usually 11am

Spoon Shoot: This is an **optional** shoot based on Handicap; enter on the day; rounds are decided among the archers present on the day. The cost will be an extra £1.50 to enter before you shoot. (June, July, and August are not)
